

Stainless Steel Cleaning Instructions

1. 1. Use Mild Soap and Water

- Mix a small amount of mild liquid dish soap with warm water.
- Soak a soft, non-abrasive cloth or sponge in the solution.

2. 2. Wipe the Surface

- Gently wipe the stainless steel surface using the damp cloth.
- Always follow the direction of the grain (if visible) to avoid streaking.

3. 3. Rinse Thoroughly

- After cleaning, rinse the area with clean water to remove soap residue.
- This helps prevent spotting or film buildup.

4. 4. Dry Immediately

- Use a clean, dry microfiber cloth to completely dry the surface.
- Drying prevents water spots and helps maintain the finish.

What to Avoid

- Do not use abrasive pads, steel wool, or rough sponges.
- Do not use bleach, chlorine, or any acidic or harsh chemical cleaners.
- Do not use glass cleaners, degreasers, or products containing ammonia.
- Do not leave standing water, tape residue, or spills on the surface.

Notes

Consistent, gentle cleaning is the best way to preserve stainless steel.
